<b>Einleitung</b>	<p>Die vereinheitlichte Verwaltungslösung Microsoft System Center Essentials 2010 ist Microsofts kostengünstige All-In-One-Lösung für die proaktive und effizientere Verwaltung von mittelständischen IT-Umgebungen. Sie enthält etablierte Komponenten der System Center-Familie wie z.B. den Operation Manager oder die Windows Server Update Services (WSUS). Dieser ZFI/Microsoft-Kurs unterstützt Sie bei der Einführung und dem Betrieb von System Center Essentials 2010 in Ihrem Unternehmen. Anhand praxisbezogener Beispiele und hilfreicher Tipps und Tricks erleichtert es Ihnen den Einstieg in das Systems-Management.
